



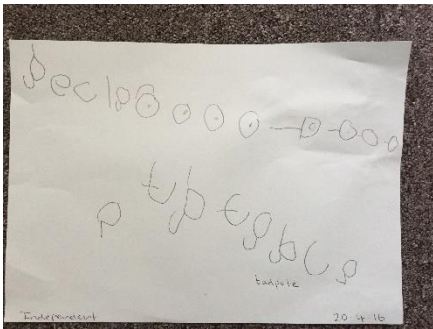
Reception News
