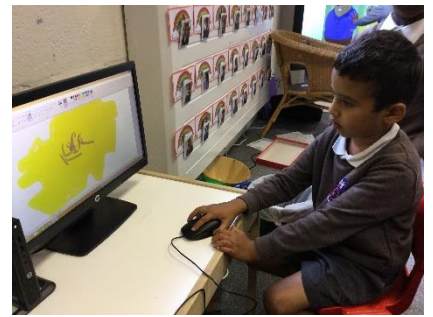


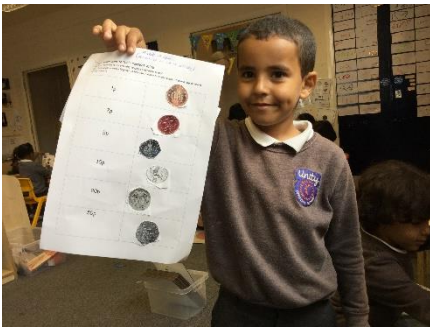
Reception News 16.6.16
