Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you all for your support and patience since the Nursery has moved to Unity. As the move was quite unexpected there have been a number of teething problems that we are trying to find solutions to. You have all been extremely understanding about these issues and we are very grateful for this.

I will try and address the main issues in this letter but if there is anything else that is worrying you please come in and speak to me at any time.

- **Prams** – A health and safety inspection last week raised concerns about prams being stored under the stairs. It is considered to be a fire hazard and is therefore not appropriate within a school. Parents need to take prams home with them after drop off **OR** lock them up in the bike shed at the front of the school.
- **Stairs** – Unfortunately the stairs at the front of the building cannot be removed and this is the only available entrance for the Nursery children. We fully appreciate that this is not an ideal situation. The children will be in this part of the building for a temporary period while a purpose built Nursery is constructed on the school grounds. This building will have a ramp and pram storage. Until that time please ask the member of staff at the door to help you with your child on the stairs.
- **Outdoor play** – At the present time the younger children cannot play outside during school playtime and lunchtime as this would not be safe for them. Again we appreciate that this is not ideal but this is a temporary situation. During the school holiday a fence will be constructed to provide the younger children with their own outside area. The children will then have unlimited access to outdoor play.

Once again, thank you all for your support and understanding with these issues.
