### Our Learning this Term

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you all had a relaxing break.

We are excited to begin a **History** unit on Changemakers. We will learn about historical figures who have made an impact on the world, including scientists, architects, Olympians, and more.

In **Geography**, we are doing a village study on Kenya. We will learn the differences between a village, town, and city, comparing Kenya and Manchester throughout the term.

In **English**, we will be exploring a meeting tale called The Secret Sky Garden and a finding tale titled The Egg Box Dragon. The children will develop a range of writing skills, with regular assessments. There will also be a strong focus on improving handwriting and spelling.

In **Science**, our topic is Animals, including Humans. The children will learn about life cycles, what living things need to survive, and how to keep themselves clean and healthy. We will also focus on the topic Living Thing and their Habitats. This topic teaches children about plants and animals, where they live, and how they are suited to their environments. They will also explore food chains and learn how to care for nature.

In **Maths**, we are following the White Rose curriculum. The children will continue learning multiplication and division, before moving on to shape and money. We will keep practising times tables, as Year 2 children expected to know their 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.



### P.E Lessons



This term, PE will take place on **Wednesday** and **Thursday**.

Children may wear their PE kit to school on Wednesdays and change back into uniform afterwards. PE kit should include: white t-shirt, black shorts or tracksuit bottoms, and trainers or pumps, all clearly labelled.

Thank you for your continued support with reading at home. Children will receive two reading books every Tuesday, which should be returned the following week.
