Our Learning this Term

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to Unity! We hope you had a lovely summer.

This term in **English** we will be learning how to write a persuasive letter, retell a story and write a poem.

In our **Guided Reading** lessons, we will look at a range of text and question types encouraging pupils to read a broad selection of genres and styles. Please can you encourage children to read regularly at home and record this in their reading record.

In **Maths**, we will be consolidating knowledge of place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

In **Science**, we will be learning about rocks.

This term our **PSHE** unit will be 'My Connections'. We will learn about boundaries within relationships and what it means to be a good friend.

This term in **History** our unit will be on the history and timeline of the Stone Age.

In **Geography**, we will learn all about Food and Farming.

In **Art**, we will be completing a prehistoric cave painting and hand on a cave wall.
